PEI Team for 2019 Atlantic Championships

For an individual to earn the right to play for team PEI at the 2019 Atlantic, he or she must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must participate in 2 PEI tournaments throughout the 2018/2019 season
- Must participate in 1 NS tournament throughout the 2018/2019 season
- Must have accumulated enough tournament points to qualify for a position (details below)
- Must be in good standing with the PEITTA

Team Positions:

<u>Category</u>	<u>Division</u>	<u># of Positions</u>
Senior	Male	4
Senior	Female	4
Junior	Male	4
Junior	Female	4

Point System:

<u>Place</u>	<u>Points</u>
1st	5 Points
2nd	4 Points
3rd	3 Points
4th	2 Points
5th	1 Point

Using the Point System as selection for Team PEI (Atlantic)

- Each individual will participate for points using the above point system in order to earn the right to play for Team PEI at the Atlantic Championships.
- Each individual will be ranked in order of PEI positions only.
- 2 PEI tournaments must be counted towards points
- A players top 2 PEI tournaments and top 1 NS tournament will be used to calculate the overall point total for that player in the team selection.
- Tiebreaker will be the 4th best tournament. If a player has only participated in 3 tournaments, their 4th tournament point total will be assumed as 0.

NS Marathon #1	4	2
NS Marathon #2	2	4
PEI Open	2	4
PEI Team Trials	5	1
Total points		13 (5+4+4)

The top 2 PEI tournaments and top 1 NS tournament will be used to calculate a players total point value. If two players were tied at 13 points, the next best tournament would be used as the tiebreaker. In this example above, the NS marathon #1 would give this player 2 points in the tiebreaker.

Disclosures

- All members must be in good standing with PEITTA and TTCAN to be considered for team positions
- Only Atlantic Team Selection Tournaments (mentioned above) count towards earning points for the team selection.
- If a tournament is cancelled, the PEITTA boards of directors have the right to schedule an alternative tournament to count towards earning team selection points.
- If a team member cannot participate in the Atlantics/Nationals, the position will be filled by the PEI player with the next highest point total.
- Juniors will be able to count towards senior point totals
- Seniors will not be able to count towards Junior point totals
- Males and Females will count separately in determining point totals
